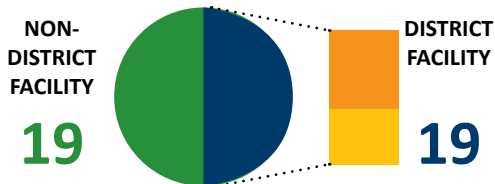

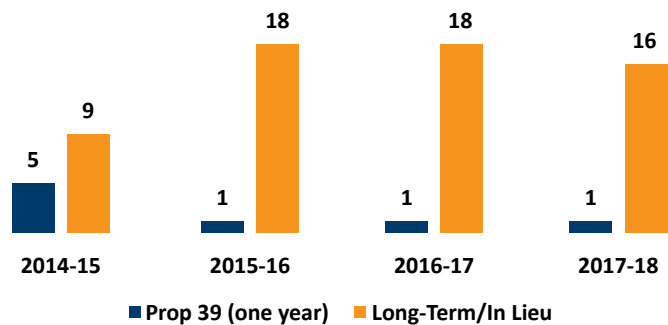

### OUSD FACILITY LEASE AGREEMENTS WITH CHARTER SCHOOLS<sup>1</sup>

Charter schools have unequivocally expressed a desire for long-term lease agreements as opposed to Prop 39 leases, which are only for one-year. OUSD has worked diligently to fulfill this preference as evidenced by the increase in long-term leases executed over the years in lieu of one-year Prop 39 leases.



For 2017-18, 49% (17 of 35) of OUSD-Authorized charter schools will be housed in OUSD facilities; only one will be on a one-year Prop 39 lease agreement.
