

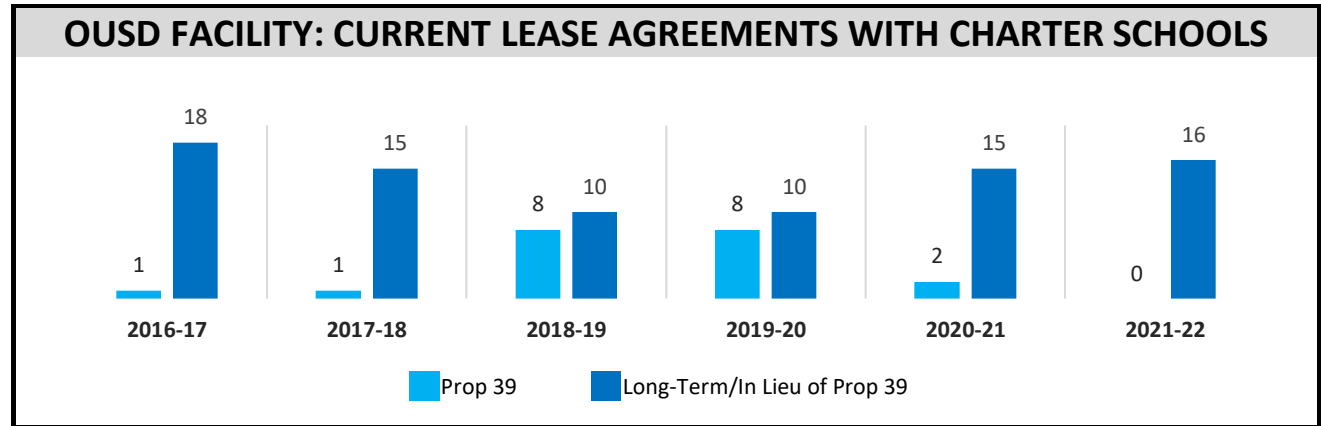

Notes: (1) Includes all 39 charter schools located across 44 sites in Oakland. Four charter schools are split across multiple campuses, including one school (Yu Ming) at three non-OUSD sites, one school (Envision) at two non-OUSD sites, and two schools (EBIA and Francophone) at both an OUSD and a non-OUSD campus. (2) Approximately 2.0% (718 students) of OUSD District-run schools' 2021-22 enrollment were not Oakland residents. (3) For Francophone and EBIA, figures shown are campus totals at OUSD sites only.
