In-District ADA Enrollment

- Currently Operating Schools: Live Go/Fall Info Update enrollment data will be used to corroborate the In-District ADA information contained in a school's facilties request form. If a school projects a "significant increase" that is greater than 10%, then additional documentation will be required (see section Operating Schools Projecting an Enrollment Increase Greater than 10% below). The "significant increase" calculation will NOT take into consideration the enrollment growth due to schools adding grade levels towards fulfillment of the authorized grade configuration. Please note, enrollment levels of matriculating grades are assumed to be similar to prior years and will not be counted as a "significant increase." Intent to Enroll/Meaningfuly Interested Students Signature forms will NOT be accepted or processed for schools projecting a "significant increase" in enrollment.

 enrollment increase <u>AND</u> the Meaningfully Interested Students Spreadsheet (Appendix III) as described
 above.

Methodology Used in Making ADA Projection:

Title 5 CCR Section 11969.9 requires the facilities request to include a description of the methodology for the ADA projections. Oakland Charter High School utilized the following methodology in calculating the ADA projections, considering 95% student attendance rate through the projected years.

Step 1: Total Possible Days of Instruction

Student Enrollment x Days of Instruction = Total Possible Days of Instruction

Step 2: Average Daily Attendance (ADA)

Total Days Possible x 95% (.95) rate of attendance/ Total Days of Instruction = Average Daily Attendance (ADA)

As demonstrated herein, we have analyzed our School's historical enrollment, retention, and growth trends, prior ADA figures, and historical wait list numbers in order to arrive at our total projected in-District classroom ADA figure for the request year. Oakland Charter High School has a retention rate of 94%. Currently, the school has 441 students, 81 seniors, and 360 students who are expected to return. In the last three years, we have accepted everyone who was at one-time on the waitlist. We always fill empty slots left by students who don't return with students from out waitlist. The school receives approximately 200 applications throughout the year/Oakland Charter High School's historical average attendance rate is 98%. We achieve this throught various practices and incentive programs like student activities, student sports, community outreach, as well as community volunteering with Oakland council members. The school used data from the following sources to extrapolate the projections for the 2017-18 school year: schools most recent attendance summary, and current enrollment. The school can determine its projected number of students based on the feeder pattern, historical data, and the included meaningfully interested student forms.

Supporting Documentation:

As you review the Oakland Charter High School ADA projections and supporting documentation, please keep in mind that the Proposition 39 regulations do not specify or require a particular type of supporting documentation to be used. Based upon the needs of the Oakland Charter High School and the residency of the projected student enrollment from within the targeted areas, therefore the school desires to occupy the District facility previously known as Lakeview Elementary School or Westlake Middle School.

Title 5 CCR Section I 1969.9(c) (I)(F) requires the facilities request to provide information regarding the charter school's educational program that is relevant to the assignment of facilities. The Oakland Charter High School (OCHS) educational does have unique facility's needs. At the high school level, The California Department of Education (COE) requires that students take a varied (A-G) required courses for high school graduation. Therefore, OCHS students will need adequate space for scientific lab work, Library/Research, Office space for Administration (including Principal, VP, and College Adviser, computer labs, and physical education space- all are needed for CDE required courses. In addition, OCHS will require work stations for Special Education, or pull out services for those students. Of course, the students will require the usage of a lunch area/cafeteria as well.

The OCHS instructional program also emphasizes the need to address academic achievement gaps as a group and relies on the seamless and ongoing communication and collaborations between subject matter and grade level teachers to meet jointly with tutors' on an ongoing basis to discuss and highlight individual and cohort student progress and needs. Having all staff and student in a single site would allow us to continue and encourage staff collaboration to assure that all of our students and subgroups receive a supportive and seamless academic support and allow the school to further develop the expansion of the Learning Lab functions thus, the Oakland Charter High School is seeking one contiguous school site.
